


# True Position Drill Guide Instruction Manual


#### **Drawer Fronts**





#### Handles

Set each sliding guide at half the overall length of hardware.




#### **Knobs**

Leave sliding guides on for stability, t-square bushing will be used to drill.




Set top stop at 1/2 the distance of drawer height or desired placement.






Draw center line on drawer front. Align top stop notches\* with center line. Hold in place & drill.





#### **Back Holes**

Remove Top Stop. ma


thumb agains back o


thumbscrews against the back of cabinet and the drilling extension against bottom of cabinet.

Hold against the back panel and drill first hole at the bottom, then second hole at the top.

Place extra drill bits in top and bottom holes to stabalize drill guide, drill remaining holes.


For longer panels, slide drill guide up and place drill bit in last hole drilled to maintain drilling pattern.






#### 32mm Shelf Holes Before Cabinet Assembly

#### Front Holes




#### **Back Holes**



Place the top stop against top of panel and extension end stop is against edge of panel.

Clamp & drill.

For longer panels, remove end stop & slide up to last hole drilled.
Place a drill bit in last hole drilled to maintain hole pattern.
